

Fulfilling the wish for a baby?

When a healthy couple are having trouble conceiving the following should be considered:

1.

Recurring vaginal mycosis could possibly be the cause since fungal toxins may block the metabolism in the lower abdomen. If this is the case the toxins need to be eliminated. This can be done using general toxin elimination via program 970 and specifically with the "eliminate mycotoxins" ampoule from the CTT test kit virus/fungi. The mycosis itself must also be treated of course.

2.

Scar interference fields, especially in the lower part of the body or scars which, for example, affect the triple warmer. Also consider internal scars e.g. through inflammation of the ovaries, surgical scars, small scars from laparoscopies etc. It may sometimes be the case that the woman has already had a child and can now no longer get pregnant. In this case it may be the result of a possible episiotomy scar.

3.

Generally attention must be paid to **geopathic or electrosmog stresses**. In this case too women who have already had a child and can no longer get pregnant should be asked whether the place where they sleep has changed and test for geopathic and electrosmog stresses.

4.

Also enquire as to the **occupations** of the couple. For example, working in a dry cleaning factory, handling paints and dyes or other harmful substances. Such substances may possibly also prevent pregnancy. For example, an artist producing lead-glazed pictures was unable to have children because of a high level of stress caused by the lead. After this stress was eliminated she was able to conceive.

5.

Also find out from the case history whether and how long the patient has prevented pregnancy by taking the **contraceptive pill**. It may be that the contraceptive pill needs to be eliminated. (Basic therapy after conductivity value test, liver detoxification, toxin elimination, hormonal disorders, eliminate contraceptive pill with program 998).

Generally speaking the **hormone programs** stored in the Bicom should be tested and treated accordingly (Program 916 regulate pituitary gland, program 934 hormonal disorders, program 980, 981 hormonal regulation).

It may be that one **partner's secretions** (vaginal secretions/sperm) are incompatible with those of the other partner, in which case the woman must be treated with the man's sperm and the man must be treated with the women's vaginal secretions using the Bicom device. This often helps to remove the incompatibility problem between partners.

Therapy for the woman

1st step: Basic therapy after conductivity value test

2nd step:

Program 700 geopathy if necessary
Program 701 radiation stress

3rd step:

Program 980 and 981
Hormonal regulation

4th step:

Program 998

Input cup: partner's sperm

Input: no electrode

Output: modulation mat on back

Therapy for the man:

1st step: Basic therapy after conductivity value test

2nd step:

Program 700 geopathy if necessary

Program 701 radiation stress

3rd step:

Program 980 and 981

Hormonal regulation

4th step:

Program 998

Input cup: woman's vaginal secretion

Input: no electrode

Output: modulation mat on back

For steps 1–3 the positioning of electrodes what to place in the input cup are described in the therapy manual. For step 4 see above. Before starting the therapy session a chip is placed in the memory device and once treatment has been completed this is attached two fingerbreadths below the navel.
